PASTOR'S MESSAGE

When I began planning what this year's Easter season was going to look like at Church of Christ Uniting, I did so not knowing that this would turn out to be a season of transition not only for the church, but for me personally. All Easter long we are asking the question "Where Are You Going?" We are asking this of the characters we're meeting in scripture on Sunday morning, we are hopefully asking this of ourselves, and we are asking it of the church (both the local and the global church). Ultimately this question deals with our vision, where we see ourselves and our church being called to in the months and years to come.

Last month I and several of my colleagues spent a day with Upper New York Bishop Hector. At the end of our time, he handed each of us a children's book that he had used while discerning his call to serve as a Bishop. The book was *What the Road Said* by Cleo Wade. I would like to share the first few words from that book with you: "Have you ever wanted to go in a different direction? Have you ever wondered if there was something more... something out there, something just... different? I did too. Then one day I was walking my usual way home when, out of nowhere, for no reason at all, almost as if it were magic, a road appeared. I could not believe my eyes, so I walked over to it and I said to the road, where do you lead?"

This July I will be celebrating my 10th year in pastoral ministry. Some of those years have been real struggles, others have been comparatively easy, all of them have been tremendous blessings. In every church I have served, including COCU, I have found people eager to try new things, explore their faith, and discover where God is leading the church. When I ask us to think about where it is we are going, I am offering an invitation to spend some real time discerning where it is God is calling you to go.

God is constantly inviting us to take the next step on our journey of faith. We may never know all the challenges or blessings we will find along the way, but we always know that the end of the journey is a fuller and deeper relationship with God. I pray that as we continue to celebrate the glory of Easter, you will discover where the road unfolding in your life leads.
