
PASTOR'S MESSAGE

Hard to believe summer is behind us, and the cool crisp air of fall is coming near. The Pumpkin spice is out, and Halloween candy is lining the shelves, which only means one thing....

The official start of the new school year, and the new Sunday School year!!



That's right, it's back to church, Sunday September 8th. Sunday School will begin during church. Our young disciples will be offered the opportunity to leave after their time with me, to head off to Sunday School. In addition, on the 8th after church during coffee hour, we will have some tables set up and information sheets/signup sheets for opportunities we have for you to be involved in the church. Some take very little time; others might take a bit more. I encourage you to walk around and speak with the chairperson or the leader of the groups and find out what they are looking for you to do as part of a committee, ministry, mission, or leadership positions.

We will begin a Membership Class on Sunday, September 15th after worship, and coffee hour after church. We will meet for 4 weeks, and then on October 6th on World Communion Sunday we will welcome our new members in church. We currently have four people signed up to attend, but anyone who would like to join us in this class is welcome to come on the 15th to begin the membership process.

Please keep our youth who will begin their journey of confirmation. Each of the boys will be asked to approach someone in the church that is unrelated to them, to become a mentor for them through this journey. The job of the mentor is to keep the boys in prayer, meet with them periodically to see how they are doing, answer any questions they might have, build a relationship with them, and teach them about their faith both in practice and in friendship. This person needs to be Safe Sanctuaries trained, if you have not taken Safe Sanctuaries, please let me know, as we will be having a class coming up soon here at church so you will have an opportunity to take the training. This would also include a background check. They will be confirmed in church on June 8th during our Pentecost Service.

Here is to a great school year for our children, youth, and teachers within our congregation. Lord, we ask that you bless each student, teacher, administrator, whoever might touch the life of a child this school year. Let them shine your light, let their faith help them through those difficult days, being reminded that you knew them in the womb before they were born and that even when they think they are not doing a good job, they are doing what you called them to do and for that, you will be blessed and be their guide.




Choir News
